Serving Oregon & SW Washington. Resource Families may request support directly on our website. Delivery is available within 30 minutes of Tigard facility. Pick up by appointment in Tigard if living outside of our delivery area.

Mission: Project 48 exists to provide support to youth experiencing foster care, ages 7-23, by providing essential items and life skills during vulnerable and traumatic transitions.
